Purpose of CBA NW

Small Grants applications

CBA NW Small Grants are intended to help archaeology groups within the region to carry out specific projects. Examples might be: equipment for field survey or excavation for a site of local significance; publication costs for a report on work carried out by the society; materials for a display on local history; activities involving young people and the community in archaeology.

You are welcome to discuss your proposal with the Secretary before submitting an application on the attached form. Applications received will be discussed by the Executive Committee at their next meeting.

Recipients of our Small Grants are required to give a **five minute presentation** at the next AGM and provide a brief report for the Newsletter. Publications and exhibitions should acknowledge the support of CBA NW.
